Please be advised that GoNorth cannot guarantee a specific vehicle make and model. Pictures of the seat belt setup are available for Motorhome 19/21ft and Motorhome 22/24ft.

Motorhome 22/24ft	2**	6	0	1

*Attention: limited space may make it difficult to accommodate 3 child seats in the second row despite the 3 anchors present)

** Driver and passenger seat in the front

In Motorhomes, if rear-facing infant seats are installed, the dinette table must be lowered, meaning no other seating is available at the dinette.
